

## Concession Tickets at Swimming Australia Ltd. Events

### Accepted Documents

Any patron wishing to purchase a ticket at the concession rate is required to present the relevant concession documentation at the box office ticket window. For purchases made online, patrons must show the valid concession documentation at the entry gate or turnstile upon entry into the venue.

Persons who do not have the appropriate form of concession documentation will not be admitted on a concession ticket.

A valid form of identification must also be presented in addition to concession documentation when purchasing concession tickets E.g. Drivers Licence, Medicare Card, Credit Card, etc.  
Please note: ID does not have to have a photo.

The following are all accepted forms of concession documentation:

- **Student Cards** – Full time secondary students, tertiary students, interstate students studying in Australia.
- **Centrelink issued - Pensioner Concession Card\*** – Aged (AGE), Bereavement Allowance (BVA), Carer (CAR), Aged Blind (AGE BLIND), Parenting Payment (single) (PPS), Disability Support Pension (DSP), Disability Support Blind (DSP Blind), Partner Allowance (PTA), Sickness Allowance (SAL), Special Benefit (SPL), Widow Allowance (WDA), Widow Pension (WID), Wife Pension (WFA/WFD/WFW), Newstart Allowance over 60 years (NSW/NMA), Mature Age Allowance (MAA), Mature Age Partner Allowance (MPA), Newstart Allowance (NSA), Parenting Payment (PPP/PPS).
- **Centrelink issued - Health Care Cards\*** - Exceptional Circumstances Relief (DR), Sickness Allowance (SA), Special Benefit (SL), Farm Help Income Support (FFR), Newstart Allowance (NS), Youth Allowance (YA), Newstart Mature Age Allowance (NMA), Parenting Payment (single) (PPS), Low Income (LI), Carer Allowance (CD), Partner Allowance (PA), Mobility Allowance (MO), and Widow Allowance (WA), Family Assistance (FA) Child Disability Allowance (CDA).
- **Department of Veterans' Affairs\*** – All cards have an expiry date and will only be accepted if current.
- **Disabled Patrons requiring the assistance of a Carer** – A Companion Card is recognised at all Swimming Australia Ltd. events. The patron with a disability must pay for his or her entry, and an additional complimentary ticket will be issued to the companion free of charge upon presentation of the Companion Card. Disabled patrons are also entitled to a concession ticket if they have the appropriate concession documentation.

*NOTE: \* Only the primary cardholder (not dependants) will be entitled to the concession price.*
