The 2021 Australian Swimming Trials will be held at SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre, 443 Morphett Road, Oaklands Park, SA from Saturday 12 to Thursday 17 June 2021. Heats will be swum in the morning and finals at night.

This is a selection event; therefore, no medals will be awarded.

5. PROGRAM OF EVENTS

This event will be conducted using 8 lanes. As 8-lanes will be used, no visitors will progress to the final. However, visitors may swim B-finals.

B-Finals will be swum for events up to and including 200m provided at least 24 swimmers contest the heats. This also applies to Multi-Class events.

Heats will be swum in reverse order with the fastest heat first, with the exception of the distance events.

Distance events are timed finals with the slow heat in the heat's session and the fast heat in the final's session (800m and 1500m).

6. QUALIFYING TIMES

The minimum age for swimmers competing at the Australian Swimming Trials is 13 years (girls), 14 years (boys) and 12 years for multi-class swimmers as at the first day of competition.

Entries will close at 11:59pm on Tuesday 25 May 2021. No late entries will be taken for this event.

9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation can be collected from the accreditation box at the event entry on pre-meet or competition days. Accreditation passes must be visible at all times and are strictly non-transferable.

Clubs are advised that they will need to apply for their accreditation passes using the link above. There are three different types of accreditation available to clubs which includes:

- Coach: (\$95)
- Team Manager (\$95)
- Support Staff (\$50)

Accreditation limits per club do apply and are as follows:

Accreditation applications must be made in advance and **WILL NOT** be accepted onsite.

MC Carers Pass: MC athletes with an 'A' exception will be the only athletes allowed to receive accreditation for a carer to assist them.

There will be an area accessible outside of the accredited zone for both parents and athletes to use for athlete swimsuit assistance.

Applications close: **Tuesday 25 May 2021 at 11:59pm.**

Please note athletes automatically receive accreditation and do not need to apply separately.

10. SELF-MARSHALLING

Self-marshalling will be in practice for this event. Athletes will be instructed by the check starter to move behind the blocks once the event (or timed final) ahead of them has entered the water.

Self-Marshalling will be located in the marshalling room next to the pool.

Self-Marshalling will take place for all heats and timed finals, (for finals refer below)

Swimmers will only be permitted to enter the self-marshalling area as follows:

- 50m events 8 heats prior to their heat
- 100m and 200m events 4 heats prior to their heat
- 400m events 2 heats prior to their heat
- 800m and 1500m events 1 heat prior to their heat

There will be check starters on hand to direct the swimmers to the pool deck.

Finals

All finals will be marshalled in the self-marshalling area.

Any swimmer entered in the first or second event of the final's session, who fails to report to the marshalling area at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the session, may be deemed to be a withdrawal.

For all subsequent finals, any swimmer who fails to report by the start of the event at least two events prior to their event, may be deemed to be a withdrawal.

A help desk will be set up at the start finish end of the pool and can be used by swimmers when they require assistance.
