

Important update regarding your intended arrival to South Australia for the Australian Swimming Trials

In line with the current direction, effective 7:45pm 28 May 2021, travellers arriving from Victoria are not permitted to enter South Australia. This includes anyone that has been in Victoria within 14 days prior to their arrival.

Victorian attendees who have been outside of the State for more than 14 days prior to their intended arrival, are not considered restricted travellers. Please follow the processes outlined in [this information](#) and have appropriate proof available for your arrival (e.g., flight details, departure dates etc.)

While there are processes in place to apply for an exemption as an essential traveller to enter South Australia for those who have been in Victoria within the 14 days prior to their intended arrival, if approved, a further exemption would be required after five days of self-isolation, seeking permission to attend the Australian Swimming Trials as the applicant would be within the mandatory 14-day self-quarantine period. This exemption is extremely difficult to obtain and it is important to note that no permission would be granted to train within this initial five day isolation period. An assessment for this critical further exemption would consider the risk to other athletes, technical officials, staff, the wider South Australian population as well as the integrity of the event with its Olympic & Paralympic team selection imperative.

It's important to note that given the current situation in Victoria, there are enhanced checks in place for compliance. A \$1,000 on-the-spot fine can be issued to anyone breaching self-quarantine requirements.

SA Health and SA Police are working together to monitor people who should be in quarantine and fines may be issued to people who breach these directives.

We understand the difficulty and share the resultant disappointment of those impacted by these current restrictions. It's also important to recognise that all respective State Governments are doing their utmost to maintain the health and safety of their community within this evolving global pandemic.
