

Important update regarding your intended arrival to South Australia for the Australian Swimming Trials

With the exception of Victoria, there are currently no restrictions on entering South Australia. However, all travellers are required to complete the [Cross Border Travel Registration](#) form on the South Australia (SA) Police website, prior to their entry.

It is recommended that you complete this form seven days before you leave. If you are within this timeframe of your intended travel, please complete it as soon as possible.

Upon completion, you will receive an email confirming your submission. Once processed, you'll receive a further email outlining your approval to enter South Australia. This approval can take up to seven days, however, recent submissions have seen approvals coming through within hours, up to a day.

All travellers should download the mySA GOV app prior to their travel. COVID Safe Check-In is required at most shops and establishments in South Australia, including the Australian Swimming Trials.

Travellers will receive an email from SA Police, requesting they complete a 'Self Check-in'. This will "check" them in as arriving in South Australia.

Travellers will either declare that they have arrived or will be arriving in South Australia as per the date declared on their Cross Border Travel Registration.

The email from SA Police will arrive on the day you are expected to arrive in South Australia.

Travellers entering SA by plane must wear a face mask (covering the mouth and nose) at all times when on the plane or within any airport.

Travellers who arrive by plane are required to use the [COVID Safe Check-In](#) to scan a QR code specific to the Adelaide Airport immediately after their arrival. For travellers who do not have a smartphone, they must provide their relevant contact details to a person authorised or required to collect such contact details.

When attending the Australian Swimming Trials, it is imperative that the published COVID Safety measures in place are understood and followed as these measures are a requirement of the approved event COVID Safe Management Plan. Swimming Australia, in collaboration with SA Aquatic and Leisure Centre and SA Health, are committed to the delivery of a COVID Safe event and want to thank in advance, all attendees for their cooperation, understanding and support.

Please ensure you're familiar with the COVID Safe measures in place at the Australian Swimming Trials prior to your attendance. These will be outlined on the event page and within Team Leader notes available in the coming days.
